Making friends at a new school can feel like a hurdle. We get around that by grouping you with people who already love what you love. If you're a football player, you join the football class. If you're a basketball player, the basketball class will be your new team.

You spend your week training, learning, and working alongside your class and a Core Teacher who acts as your teacher, mentor, and biggest supporter. This team bond makes showing up easier. You support each other through the coursework because you're all chasing similar goals. Whether you're an elite athlete with a heavy training schedule or a club player who just loves the game, you belong here.



THREE WAYS TO **WIN** THE HSC

The traditional HSC path can feel like a struggle for a lot of students. That's why we offer three ways to get your certificate and finish school strong while you focus on sport both inside and outside the classroom.

You get to choose the pathway that feels right for you.

Non-ATAR HSC

Most of our students choose our Non-ATAR HSC. This pathway clears away the exam stress and lets you focus on sport, practical skills and workplace experiences. Importantly, if you're keen to go to uni you can absolutely do this without an ATAR. Each year around 20% of our Non-ATAR students go straight to degree courses at uni.

Non-ATAR Trade HSC

If you want to get a head start on a career in the trades, our Non-ATAR Trade HSC incorporates a school-based apprenticeship. You graduate with our Non-ATAR HSC in one hand and the first year of an apprenticeship in the other.

Vocational ATAR HSC

For those who want to get an ATAR, we also offer a Vocational ATAR HSC. This isn't your typical ATAR, though. While our Vocational ATAR opens another door to university, maintains our lower-pressure approach and puts the focus on sport and vocational education.

Sitting at a desk for six hours a day doesn't work for everyone - we keep our students engaged by bringing the classroom into the real world. You might find yourself at a game, touring a high-performance training center, chatting with the elite athlete who mentors your class or learning from people who work in the sports industry. We hold sport training every week, our students deliver sports clinics in primary schools and there's a whole term of strength & conditioning run by qualified coaches.

We call these our *Game-Changing Experiences* because they show you why your schoolwork actually matters and how you can live an active and healthy life. These moments add some extra spark to your studies and help you feel more connected to the world you'll enter after Year 12. It's school, but with a lot more fun and movement.







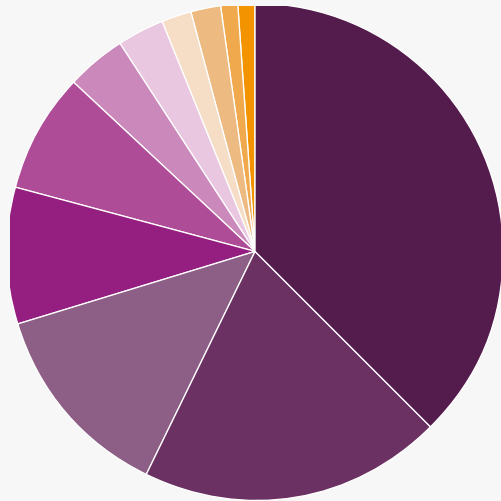


LIFE AFTER GOAL

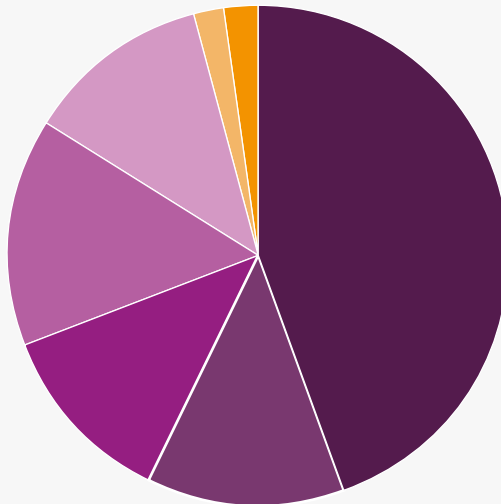

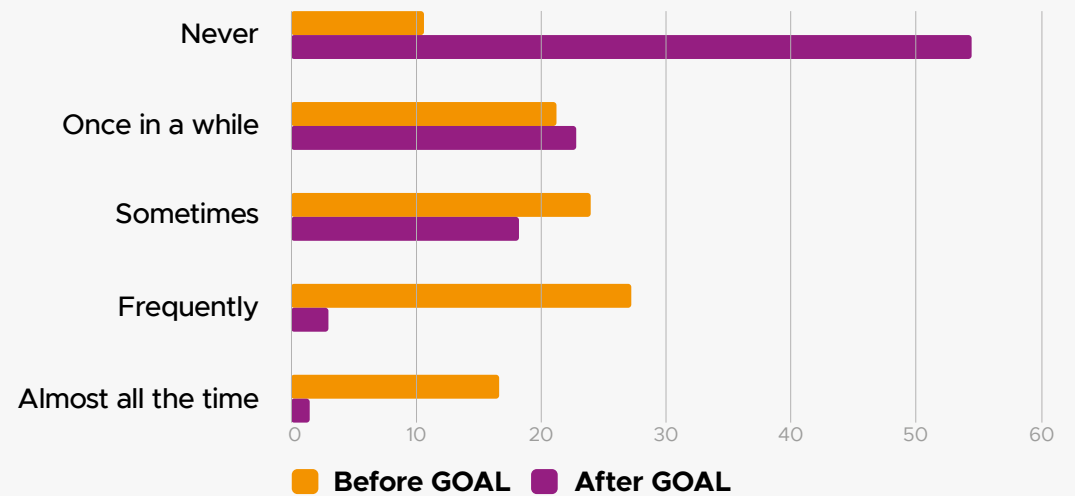

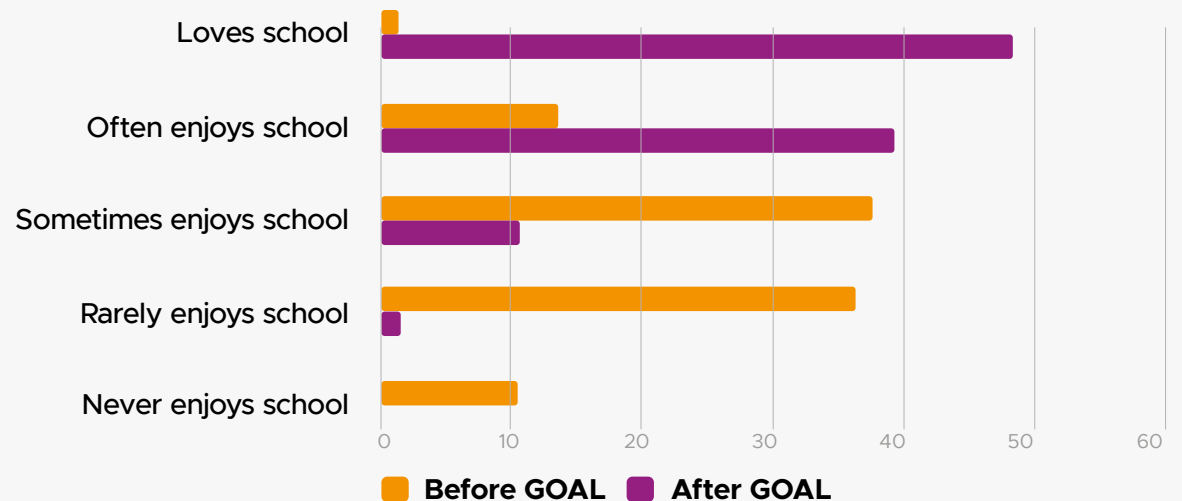
